Highlights

- 95% of students would recommend St. Patrick's Community School to a friend.
- 95% of parents and students agreed that students have access to the appropriate services at school such as social emotional support and connection to resources in the community.
- In Grade 6 and 9 Provincial Achievement Tests, 16% of students achieved a standard of excellence and 74% of students met the acceptable standard.
- 40% of staff actively participated in a staff-led faith development group.

Targeted Areas

- ✓ As a result of a slight decline (96% to 92%) in those who agree that students are engaged in their learning at school, St. Patrick's will target professional development and collaboration to develop engaging strategies so that students can participate in authentic and engaging learning opportunities.
- ✓ Increase staff and student participation in authentic acts of service within the community. Staff and students will learn about their role as Catholics through the Catholic social teaching.
